



In 2016, organized a PatternFly meet-up and a subsequent UXD-dev meet-up, which resulted in the delivery of the PatternFly roadmap


Slack

- Changed default variant to default. To maintain current default behavior, set the variant property to info. (#3903).
- If you were previously using the action prop for the close button, use the actionClose prop instead (#4190)
- If you were previously using the action prop for a link button, use the actionLinks prop instead (#4190)

Application launcher

• Removed deprecated prop dropdownItems . the prop items should be used instead (#3929)



Accessibility Updates: clean up and flexibility

- Accessibility clean up:
 - Aria naming consistencies
 - Aligned the aria-related prop names to use a naming convention of a human readable label for the element conjoined with the attribute name you're setting. For example, closeButtonAriaLabel - for these cases, the exact prop names are dependent on the component in question.
 - <u>Drawer attributes</u>- cleaned up aria attributes
 - <u>Removed outdated/deprecated attributes</u> (such as rememberMeAriaLabel)
- <u>Removed problematic default headingLevel</u>
 - When you have a default h1 heading level, a user can easily have an accessibility issue- using multiple h1s on a page so SR users can't determine the structure of the page easily
- Set ability customizable label to About Modal close button for increased flexibility

Accessibility Updates: components

- <u>Chip group refactor</u>: improved structure and screen reader experiencenested chips sound better in screen reader
- Modal updates
 - Updated attributes to improve screen reader experience
 - Set up for cases where users are supplying their own header or modal content but haven't supplied an accessible name for them
 - Tries to build in flexibility by making props optional while also warning you if you haven't provided an accessible name that will cause a11y errors
- <u>Progress component update</u>: wasn't reading in screen reader, needed tweaks to the a11y structure/attributes
- Ensured that <u>tooltip examples</u> were keyboard accessible

PatternFly React update

Design Changes

- Accordion: Removed ability to disable box shadow
- Button:
 - Allow icon to be used in any variant.
 - Allow text/icons to be placed on either side of one another
- Card: Support flat variation
- Chip Group: Updated to supports new design improve the API
- Dropdown:
 - Added support for adding an image to toggle
 - Added support to DropdownItem component for displaying non-interactive text as plain text
- Divider: Added vertical variation
- Empty State: Added full height support

Design Changes (cont.)

- Form:
 - Added support for form label icon.
 - Added support for adding an Icon to FormHelperText
- Label: refactor for updated design and features including support for
 - Changing color
 - Adding an icon to the label
 - Closing the label
 - Filled or outlined variants
- Nav: variant prop has been moved from NavList to Nav.
- Tab: Added TabTitleText and TabTitleIcon wrapper for proper styling in the Tab
- Table:
 - Added TableText component to help display text better in Grid layouts.
 - Adds new decorators (nowrap, truncate, fitContent, breakWord) that can be passed to transforms and cellTransforms.

API Improvements

- Alert: action prop was removed and two new props added. actionClose for the close button and actionLinks for one or more link buttons.
- Gutter: Fixed type for gutter support in layout components.
- Modal:
 - Rename noPadding prop to hasNoBodyWrapper
 - Remove hideTitle prop. title prop is now optional
- Tab:
 - Changed prop variant to component.
 - Changed TabVariant enum Name to TabComponent.
- Wizard:
 - Remove inPage prop. By default the Wizard will be displayed in page, filling its parent container.
 - isOpen prop will displayed wizard in a modal.
 - Updated string props to be React nodes

Default behaviour updates

- Alert: Changed default alert variant to default
- Empty State: Changed the default width to full instead of large
- Modal: Align actions to left by default
- Popover: Updated default popover header size to medium

Clean up

- Application launcher: Removed the deprecated prop dropdownItems
- Empty State Icon:
 - Removed unused props title and size
 - Variant small has been updated to sm
 - Variant large has been updated to lg
- Modal: Collapses the isLarge and isSmall properties into a single variant property.
- Select: Change isExpanded to isOpen
- Table: Change type of onSelect in Table from (event:

```

React.FormEvent<HTMLInputElement>) => void
```

- Wizard Nav: Removed prop isCompactNav . This prop is no longer used.
- TextInput, TextArea, FormGroup and FormSelect: Removed isValid prop, validated prop should be used instead.
- Removed experimental exports
- Resolved Typescript errors in integration app

Refactoring

- Renamed Toolbar Layout to PageHeaderTools and Renamed DataToolbar to Toolbar.
- react-styles: Removed emotion and fixed types

PatternFly Core update

Table - improved content/layout tools

- Text wraps less aggressively by default
- Enable aggressive wrapping for cells with long strings (ie, URLs)
- Table header cell truncates by default
- Enable body cell text truncation
- Disable text wrapping entirely
- Have text fit itself to the existing space instead of expanding it

Vertical navigation

- Navigation now hides at 1200px viewport width instead of 768px
 - Allows for more consistent layout of elements in the main section before and after the vertical navigation is hidden
- Now dark theme by default
 - A light theme variation is now available for users who prefer a light theme




