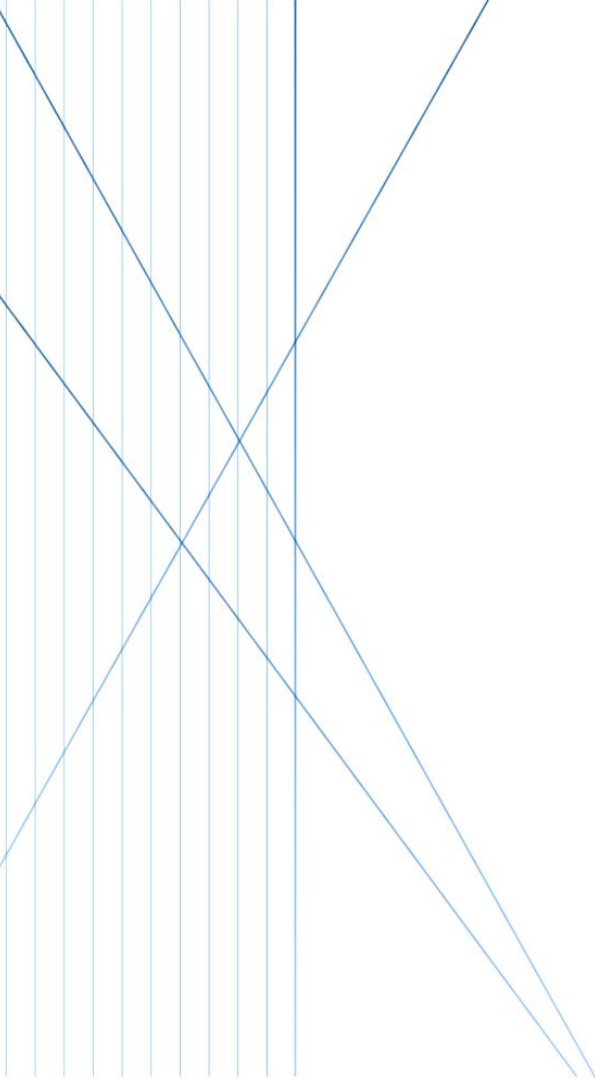

# Improving patternfly.org navigation

A user study was conducted during Q1 22 to explore users' ability to find content on the PatternFly website ([report](#)). Key findings included:

- Navigation challenges stem from recalling terms. Terms used on the Patternfly website may not always match users' expectations.
- Users have difficulty differentiating between Components and Demos.

Improvements proposed:

- Reorganize and rename content to match users' mental model.
- Reduce number of top level navigation items.
- Introduce a new visual catalog view to make component browsing easier.





# Planned IA changes

1. Move the **Community, Contribute, and Release notes** pages to the **Get started** section.
2. Rename **Guidelines** section to **Design foundations**. Keep fundamental styling information here.
3. Combine current **components** and **demos** into a single category named **Components**.
4. Introduce a new **Patterns** category that can contain both design conventions and other demos that don't fit with components.
5. Integrate [tertiary expandable navigation](#) for deeper nesting.

Proposed updates were validated through user testing [TreeJack](#).

# PF.org accessibility improvements

- Before this effort:
  - Components were each tested for a11y - manually + automated
  - PF.org had not been evaluated
- Motivated to improve website a11y to demonstrate the process of evaluating and improving a11y



# PF.org accessibility improvements

This report runs the [patternfly-a11y](#) tool, which is built using [axe-core](#).

It checks PatternFly.org's accessibility by running the automated testing on the following pages:

- The home page at a desktop + mobile viewports width with the sidebar nav open + closed
- Crawls the pages linked in the side navigation
- Crawls the multiple tabs under each component's documentation pages
- The composable table, legacy table, and html table document pages a second time at a mobile viewport width

# PF.org accessibility improvements

## Summary:

- Tested URLs: 490
- Pass: 118
- Fail: 372
- Pass rate: 24.08%
- Accessibility issues: 1066

# PF.org accessibility improvements

Currently, we are over halfway through addressing violations flagged using automated testing

[View latest report run on July 21st, 2022](#)

Summary:

- Tested URLs: 501
- Pass: 451
- Fail: 50
- Pass rate: 90.02%
- Accessibility issues: 219

There is [a PR open](#) to address violations originating in the core documentation which will address a significant number of the remaining violations
