# PF v5 Alpha testing

- If you are interested in testing v5, you can check the alpha versions in the react-docs package.json file of our p5 branch
  - https://github.com/patternfly/patternfly-react/blob/v5/packages/react-docs/package.json
- You could also use ncu to get the latest alpha versions using this command:
  - npx npm-check-updates -t @alpha -f '/^@patternfly/'
- To report issues or ask questions, please feel free to reach out on patternfly.slack.com
- Although the alpha versions will likely have breaking changes that we don't yet have codemods for, we recommend running the codemods when testing alpha versions to both help your transition and to identify any possible issues.



### Code mods

- We are developing codemods to go along with the breaking changes in PF v5
- Anyone can run these on their code at any time with `npx pf-codemods ./src`, here is what it looks like running the codemods we have so far on the PatternFly React code





# PF Release Survey Summary



**Goal**: Patternfly has not gone through a major release over the last 2 years. There is concern that without a more predictable and accepted schedule, adoption of future changes will be more challenging.

• That said, the PF team was interested in understanding the optimal cadence for future releases of Patternfly, for both major and other releases (i.e. security, minor, patches etc.)



**Method**: Survey (20 full responses)



### Key Findings:


- 1. The cadences respondents preferred generally lined up with the PF team's current and planned cadences.
  - a. The majority (60%) of respondents want the PF team to present major releases once a year. For minor releases, once every few weeks the most popular cadence (40%), and as often as needed for patches (80%)
- 2. There was a mix of levels of PF release adoption; Given the current cadence line up with respondent preferences, this suggests that factors other than PF release cadence are affecting adoption.
  - a. Some factors mentioned that could affect adoption of releases included quality of documentation, collaboration with product teams, breaking changes, timing with respect to summit, etc.
- 3. Respondents rated documentation/upgrade guides as the most important resource for them with respect to the adoption of PF releases (2.6 out of 3; 0 being not at all & 3 being very important).
  - a. "Code Mods" and "PatternFly Staff" had a similar average importance rating of 1.8 and 1.6 respectively.
  - b. Multiple pain points and opportunities were identified with respect to supporting documentation.

  - More demos and documentation coming soon!






